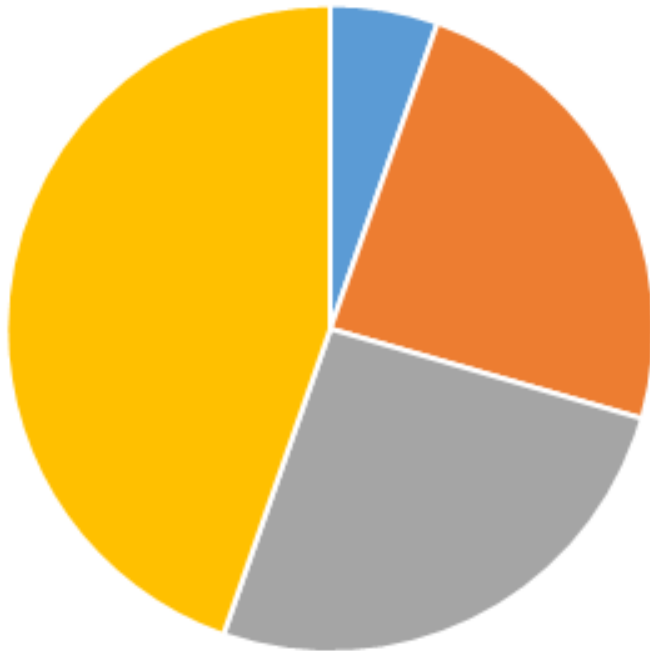

Y6 Maths SAT's 2017



■ Year 3 ■ Year 4 ■ Year 5 ■ Year 6

Year 3 – 6 marks (5%)
Year 4 – 27 marks (24%)
Year 5 – 29 marks (26%)
Year 6 – 50 marks (45%)

Lower KS2 – 33 marks (29%)
Upper KS2 – 79 marks (71%)

- * The data shows that the content in Year 4 makes up a large proportion of the Y6 SATS tests.

Times Tables

Expectation that children know all times tables to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4.

Formal test at the end of the year. This is done individually on a computer. The children have 6 seconds to answer.

Times Tables Rock Stars accounts for children to practise.

Regular reading impacts a child's success at school.
If not addressed early the educational gap widens...

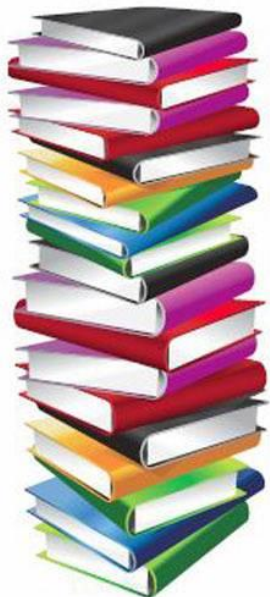
